- to search the premises for relevant property; and
- to break open, and search for relevant property, any cupboard, drawer, chest, trunk, box, package or other receptacle, whether a fixture or not, on or in the premises; and
- to take possession of, or secure against interference, any relevant property found on or in the premises; and
- to deliver to the trustee, or to any person authorised in writing by the trustee for the purpose, any property of which possession is taken under the warrant.
