What is a Family Consultant



Who gets to know what I say?



The family consultant talks to your Mum and Dad about your feelings and ideas to help make plans that are good for you.



You will not have to make choices about your mum or dad.

Family consultants help kids and their mums and dads with problems

If you are worried that what you say might upset your Mum or Dad, tell the family consultant first.

Lots of families see family consultants



What does a Judge do?

If your parents are still not sure about what might be best for you, they then talk to a judge.

Parents talk to the judge in a courtroom. Kids do not go into the courtroom – so the family consultant will talk to the judge about your feelings and ideas.



After listening to your Mum and Dad and the family consultant, the judge will then decide what's best for you and your family.

What happens next

After the judge decides, there might be some more changes in your family –



or things may stay the same.
